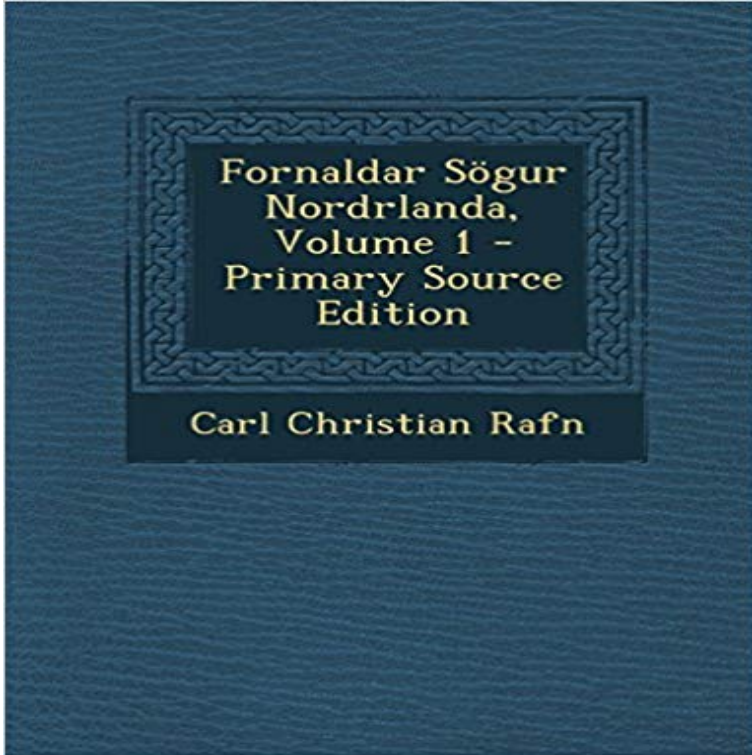


Fornaldar Sögur Nordrlanda, Volume 1 - Primary Source Edition (Old Norse Edition)
